## Program Description & Objectives

This program is designed to provide OB/GYN physicians and other health professionals with in-depth information in areas experiencing rapid advances or controversial management in obstetrics and gynecology. The goal is to update participants in the most current techniques and provide practical guidance in navigating controversial issues. It is hoped that this knowledge will enable practitioners to provide better case management and counseling to patients faced with specific conditions.

Goals of the Symposium encompass both gynecological and obstetrical issues and include:

- Review the current status of hormone replacement therapy
- Outline the criteria for screening for cervical cancer and the management for endometrial cancer
- Managing and following cancer survivors
- Define the new criteria for gestational diabetes
- Update on the use of magnesium sulfate for the prevention of cerebral palsy
- Discuss approaches for minimally invasive surgery
- Assess the need and impact of 3D ultrasound in maternal fetal medicine.
